# Finding Unity In A Divisive World

### The Mindset of Christ

"I appeal to you, dear brothers and sisters, by the authority of our Lord Jesus Christ, to live in harmony with each other. Let there be no divisions (schismata) in the church. Rather, be of one mind, united in thought and purpose." 1 Cor. 1:10 NLT

• Have you ever encountered a "worldly" Christian?

**Paul's Purpose:** To restore the Corinthian church to spiritual unity. #1 "Divisions" 1:10 to 4:21.

#### **The Central Lesson and Application:**

Let "The Mind Of Christ" bring harmony to your divisive world.

#### I. WHO MAKES YOU SO SUPERIOR? 4:7a

"For what gives you the right to make such a judgment?" NLT This implies that their supposed superiority lacks\_support.

#### A. Leaders Must REJECT Pride.

(Parties: 1 Cor. 1:12; 3:4, 22) Paul rejected his esteem as a detraction from God's glory destroying harmony. "Live in harmony with each other. Don't be too proud to enjoy the company of ordinary people. And don't think you know it all." Rom. 12:16 NLT

#### B. Leaders Have A TEAM Ministry 3:5-7 NLT

"After all, who is Apollos? Who is Paul? We are only God's servants through whom you believed the Good News. Each of us did the work the Lord gave us. I planted the seed in your hearts, and Apollos watered it, but it was God who made it grow."

#### C. A BIBLICAL Worldview Is Important! 4:6 NLT

"If you pay attention to what I have <u>quoted from the Scriptures</u>, you won't be **proud** of one of your leaders at the expense of another." 4:6.

Paul always presented a Biblical worldview. (4:6), "...I have quoted from the Scriptures," Paul spoke relying only on the Holy Spirit (2:1-6). He decided to "forget everything except Jesus Christ, the One who was crucified," (2:2); "...I relied only on the power of the Holy Spirit. I did this so you would not trust in human wisdom but in the power of God," (2:3-5). Paul was criticized for his preaching. "In person he is weak and his speeches are worthless." 2 Cor. 10:10

# Has a cultural worldview influenced you? Are you influenced by Secular Humanism? By Materialism?

1 Cor. 3:11, "For no one can lay any foundation than the one we already have— Jesus Christ." (Compare Col. 1:15-21)

## II. WHAT DO YOU HAVE THAT YOU DID NOT RECEIVE? 4:7b Everything in Christ is free!

- A. GIFTS "Born Again" Disciples Receive In Christ. 1:2-31; Jn. 3:3
- B. We FIND <u>UNITY</u> In "The Mind Of Christ!" 2:16b
  "...let the Spirit renew your thoughts and attitudes." Eph. 4:23-24
  - 1. Jesus Prayed We Would Be ONE! Jn. 17:20-23
  - 2. We Are To Have The MINDSET Of Jesus! Phil. 2:5-11

#### WHAT CHRIST'S THINKING (MIND) WAS LIKE

- **1. The Mind Of Christ Was <u>SUBMISSIVE</u>**. **Phil. 2:6** Submission: means "action and effect of submitting oneself." It is a synonym for "Surrender" of self will.
- **2. The Mind Of Christ Was To Be A SERVANT.** Jesus' motto was Mark 10:45: "For even the Son of Man came not to be served but to serve others and to give *His life as a ransom for many."*
- **3. The Mind Of Christ Was SACRIFICIAL**. Jesus realized that the price of service was a criminal's "death by the cross." Phil 2:8 (Mk. 8:34; 14:36c; 1 Pet. 2:5; Rom. 12:1)

## III. IF EVERYTHING YOU ARE IS A GIFT, WHY <u>BOAST</u> OVER EARNING NOTHING? 4:7

"And if everything you have is from God, why boast as though it were not a gift?"

This last question is in logical sequence that forces an admission, that removes all grounds or basis for a divisive superior attitude.

- Disputing is "foolishness" if based on the <u>FOLLY</u> of Human wisdom. (3:20).
- Everything is yours! You have everything you need now! (3:21-23) "So no one should boast in human leaders for everything is yours whether Paul or Apollos or Cephas (Peter) or the world or life or death or things present or things to come everything is yours, and you belong to Christ, and Christ belongs to God." 3:21-23

#### Conclusion

Let "The Mind Of Christ" bring harmony to your divisive world.

He has sounded forth the trumpet
That shall never call retreat;
He is sifting out the hearts of men
Before His judgment seat;
Oh, be swift, my soul, to answer Him;
Be jubilant, my feet;
Our **God** is marching on.
